

Pupils Premium Allocation 2012/13

Information for Parents

Cherry Oak School

The Pupil Premium for 2012/2013 has been allocated to Local Authorities for pupils on roll in January 2012 and that are known to have been eligible for free school meals (FSM) at any time in the last six years. This equated to 35 pupils. Each of these pupils attracted £738 which amounted to £25,830

Schools have been given the freedom to spend pupil premium in a way that they think will best support raising of attainment of the most vulnerable pupils

Cherry Oak School has focused on gaining evidence from parents confirming their child is eligible for FSM in order to receive maximum Pupil Premium entitlement.

The Pupil Premium payment is held in a separate cost centre so that we can track the spending. Use of Pupil Premium is reported to the Governing Body and is a standing agenda item at Federation Leadership Team meetings.

The Federation Leadership Team discussed the best use of Pupil Premium allocation and the following initiatives were decided to support outcomes for vulnerable pupils and to impact on teaching and learning and achievement at Cherry Oak.

- Provision of additional TA support
- 5 ipads plus apps
- Contribution towards minibus costs for curriculum and enrichment activities
- Contribution towards enrichment activities
