Information for Parents

The Pupil Premium for the academic year 2014/2015 has been allocated to Local Authorities for pupils on role that are known to be eligible for free school meals (FSM) at any time in the last six years. The funding amounted to £37,000. This is the allocation up to March 2015, should any additional funding be received this will be reported on the website.
